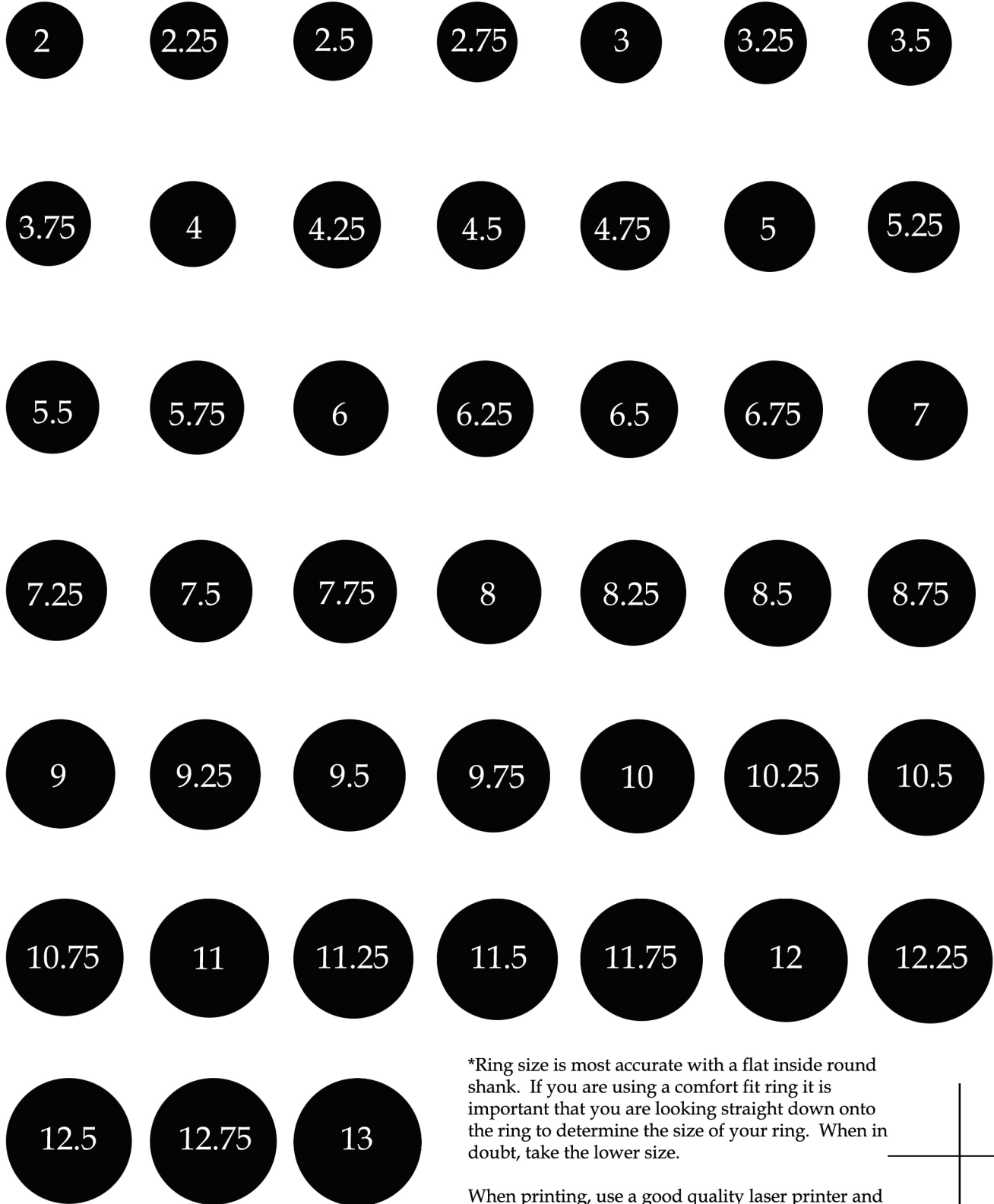


# Ring Size Page

Use this chart to determine the size of existing rings. Print out this sheet and place on a flat hard surface. Take an existing ring and place over the circles, moving them up the size chart until you no longer see white around the edges. Move down one size and you should barely see white around the inside of the ring. This is your ring size\*.



\*Ring size is most accurate with a flat inside round shank. If you are using a comfort fit ring it is important that you are looking straight down onto the ring to determine the size of your ring. When in doubt, take the lower size.

When printing, use a good quality laser printer and do not resize the page. This will affect the size of the circles. Adobe reader scales pages to 'Shrink Large Pages' by default. The crosshair to the right should be 1"x1".
